**Criteria:**

- Riders in the Rider Award program must be current members of Dressage Canada to earn awards. Riders may earn an award on a horse owned by another who is not a Dressage Canada member.
- Owners of horses in the Horse Award program must be current Dressage Canada members.
- Scores must be earned at Equine Canada National competitions or at National/International competitions in another country.
- Scores earned outside Canada must be reported on a separate form.
- The onus of proof for tests ridden outside of Canada rests with the owner/rider.
- Scores will be credited only from the year in which the horse/rider is registered and forward.
- Horses/riders may be registered prior to earning any scores.
- Scores from years prior to registration will not count.
- Horse and Rider awards may only be earned once at any level.
- Rider scores are cumulative, and may be earned on more than one horse.
- Horse scores are also cumulative and may be earned with more than one rider.
- 'Judges required' refers to the number of different judges under which scores must be earned. Where there is more than one judge on the ring, only the final average score will count and it will count as one judge.
- FEI Child & Pony tests will count as Second Level, FEI Junior tests as Third Level and FEI YR tests as PSG.
- FEI Young Horse 5 YO tests will count as Second Level and 6 YO tests as Third Level.

Freestyle criteria are the same as those for the technical tests at that level.

Lauren Dilanni Freestyle award – 3 scores of 65% or more at Second Level or higher earned at National shows. The available prize money each year will be split among those who have earned qualifying scores.

Lifetime registration fees:

\$50 for riders (does not include membership)

\$100 for horses, transferable on sale (does not include membership)
